Greens Report

Recently, Superintendent Keene sent soil samples from several different locations around the course (including the ninth green) to the University of Florida for analysis and to determine if we have any turf issues that need to be addressed.

Upcoming maintenance/improvement activity on the golf course includes dredging the creek from in front of the tee box on the second hole all the way to Bimini Bay. This will occur during the week of April 22nd. It will not be necessary to close the course to complete this task, but we ask that you be alert and aware of workers between the 5th and 6th fairways on those dates.

Additionally, the golf course periodically needs to be closed for a day to complete an aerification of the greens. This also includes sanding, fertilizing and thoroughly watering all greens. This spring the date golf course will be closed for aerification is Friday, May 10th.

As I think everyone is aware, the golf staff has been shorthanded for a significant period of time. As we move into warmer weather and a more favorable period for growing grass, we simply cannot continue without additional staff. A partial solution to this problem has been identified and hired which will allow the staff to expand their focus beyond roughs, fairways and greens.

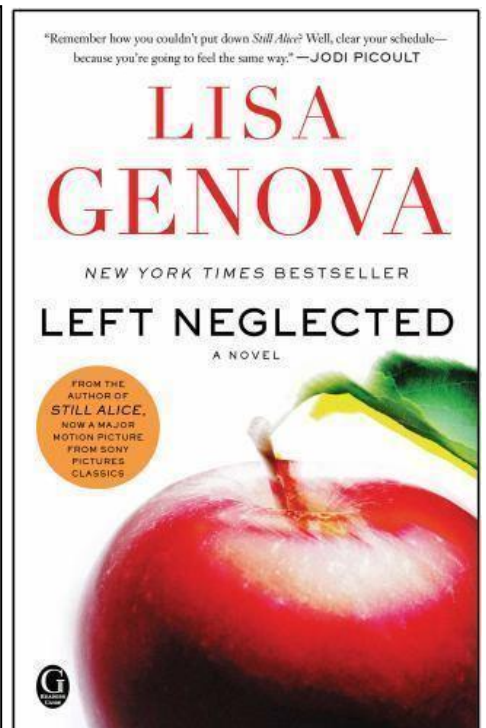
