GOLF COMMITTEE PROGRESS REPORT

GREENS REPORT

Hopefully, by the time you read this report, sod will have been laid on the sixth tee box and behind the seventh green. It will take approximately two weeks for the sod to take root prior to allowing regular play in these areas.

Recently, soil samples from multiple locations throughout the course were sent to the University of Florida for analysis. We anticipated that the results would confirm that we have a nematode problem. Nematodes are subterranean creatures that feast on roots; in our situation this is especially troublesome on and near the greens. Our concern was verified, and we hope to present a possible solution to the membership within the next month.

Not anticipated (due to the large amount of rain we received during July and August) an elevated level of sodium was also present in the soil. To counter this, Superintendent Keene will be using liquid fertilizer and spreading gypsum throughout the course.

We have not lost focus on the fact that **DRAINAGE** is the elephant in the room (or in this case, on the course). The board of directors has met with a geological engineer for input and we are presently seeking bids on what the financial implications would be to solve this problem. You will be apprised on the results of these efforts before any final decisions are made and executed.

Despite the various troublesome issue's we are attempting to address, the overall state of the Key Royale Golf Course is in amazing shape. We hope as more of our golfing members return from their summer hiatus, that everyone will play often and enjoy the efforts of our golf staff.
