



KRC HOLE-IN-ONE Program – June 2021

Introduction

Making a Hole-in-One is an exciting achievement and worthy of celebration and recognition. Proper golf etiquette suggests that the member who makes a Hole-in-One celebrates with other members of the club by buying a round(s) of beverages. The KRC Hole-in-One program provides a monetary award which can also be used to offset the cost of buying beverages.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

1. Membership into the KRC HOLE-IN-ONE program is voluntary and open to all KRC Men & Women Members 21 and older with a member account. Summer Members and Guests not eligible.
2. Participating members may enroll in the program at any time.
3. Members who do not want to join need do nothing.
4. **\$5** will be charged to enrolled member account at the time of a winning HOLE-IN-ONE.
5. Members must be enrolled prior to the HOLE-IN-ONE to qualify.
6. The HOLE-IN-ONE Pot will grow as more members sign up to the program (anticipated to be \$500+).
7. Winning HOLE-IN-ONE member enrolled in program receives a credit to their account equal to the amount in the Pot.
8. Member uses the credit as they choose but proper etiquette is to use it to buy beverages for fellow members, pay the tab and tip the servers.
9. Participating members must abide by all rules set forth below.

Enrolling

1. Enrolling is done via the KRC Website.
2. Members not having access to the website please contact the Golf Committee Chair for assistance.
3. All members who have enrolled will be listed on the website.
4. Enrolled members remain enrolled indefinitely, no need to re-enroll after each HOLE-IN-ONE.
5. Members may cancel enrollment at any time
6. To cancel enrollment please contact the Golf Committee Chair.
7. Members who cancel enrollment are not eligible to re-enroll for 12 months



HOLE-IN-ONE PROGRAM RULES

Qualifying Hole-in-One Must Meet These Criteria to Get Payout:

1. Made by a current KRC Golf Member in good standing who has enrolled in the KRC HOLE-IN-ONE Program at least 24 hours prior to the HOLE-IN-ONE.
2. Witnessed by at least one other player in the group (Member or Guest).
3. Made with the first ball & stroke played in accordance with USGA Rules with no penalty strokes.
4. Played from the proper Tee:
 - a. Member's Normal Tee (example Blue), or a longer Tee (example Black) – OR -
 - b. When playing in a KRC official organized event, played from event-designated regulation Tee.
5. Play is from KRC Regulation Tee Box and to Regulation Green.
 - a. Shortened Tees Do NOT Qualify - If the tee box has been shortened from regulation due to maintenance or any other reason whereby the tee is considered an "alternate" tee box.
 - b. Modified Holes Do NOT Qualify – if the green and hole are modified due to maintenance, the flagstick is not on normal green and/or hole is larger than regulation and any other reason whereby the Hole is considered "Modified" from regulation.
6. Player completes a regulation round, whether stroke play, match play or approved event-designated format. If event requires hitting more than one ball, only the first ball, first stroke qualifies.
7. Member submits scorecard to Golf Committee Chair with:
 - a. Score of completed round
 - b. Signed by HOLE-IN-ONE Winner and Witnesses
 - c. Date, Time, Hole, approximate yardage and club used written on scorecard
8. The HOLE-IN-ONE is validated and signed-off by the Golf Committee Chair for eligibility .

Note - All disputes and rulings decided by the Golf Committee Chair.
